

### REALISATION OF PENALTY FROM TICKETLESS PASSENGERS

The government as per G.O(P) No.1/2008/Tran dated 05.01.2008 have delegated powers to the officials of KSRTC of and above the rank of inspectors to realise penalty @ Rs.500/- from passengers in KSRTC buses who do not possess valid pass/ticket as per section 178(1) of the Motor Vehicle Act.

KSRTC after issuing detailed instructions for the guidelines of Inspectors and other officers for the proper exercise of the delegated powers and after giving wide publicity, have implemented the system in 3/2008.

The services of Surprise Squad Inspectors under the guidance of Vigilance Officer were being utilized for implementation of the system. Altogether an amount of Rs.20,83,000/- has been realized from ticketless on this account. The entire amount which is due to Government is remitted to Treasury under 'General Revenue Account'.

The details of amount realized on this account since the implementation of the system are given below.
